Parameters for Submission:

Do you like to magnify and look at things close-up? Or would you rather do a scene of an entire garden? Whatever stage of plant life excites you, we want to see it in your artwork!

Size: All artwork to be 5" x7" finished size (either horizontal or vertical orientation).

Number of Allowed Submissions: No limit on how many pieces you submit/donate.

Mediums and Techniques: 2-D Art, design, and stitch using any art medium and any substrate. (Not accepting 3-D pieces.) Suggestions:

- Textile art
- Collage (paper or textile)
- Embroidery
- Paper with paint, felt pens, crayons
- Textures from mediums/papers/silk paper/ flower petals or leaves
- Natural dye pieces or botanical printmaking on either cloth or paper
- Stitched photographs (printed on paper or fabric)
- Hand-made block prints
- Beaded artwork
- Let your imagination go wild!



Color Scheme: Any that fits the theme and your image.

Finishing: Textile art edges should be finished. Paper arts can have raw edges. Please do NOT frame or mat.

Labeling: Please label your artwork on the back side—1. Name of artwork (give it a name e.g. underwater lilies), 2. your name, 3. Materials and methods/techniques used in the piece.
